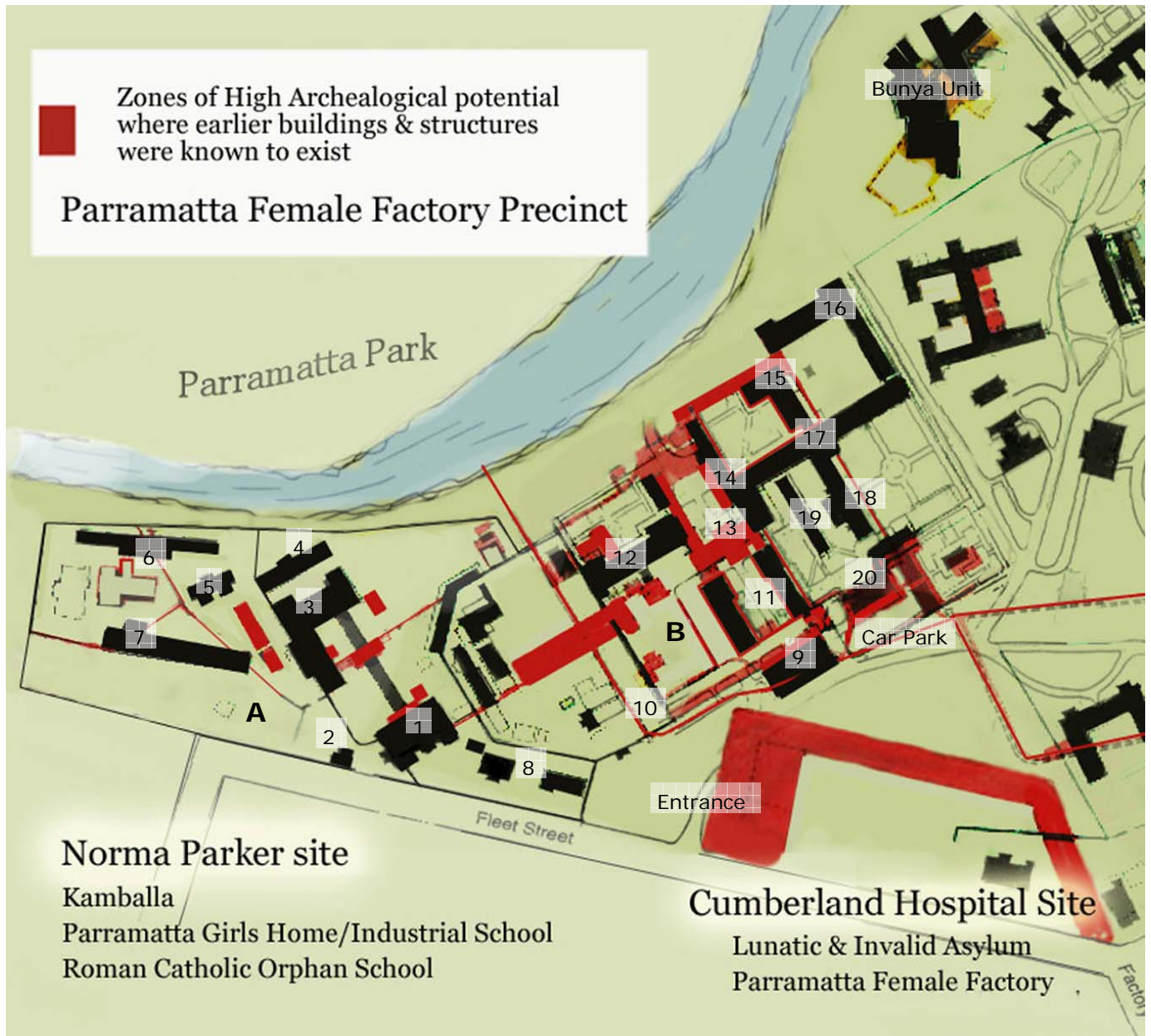


The Precinct comprises two historic sites: Parramatta Female Factory (1821—1847 ) now Cumberland Hospital; and the Roman Catholic Orphan School (1841—1886) now Norma Parker Centre. The Female Factory became the Parramatta Lunatic and Invalid Asylum in 1847 and the Orphan School became the Parramatta Girls Industrial School in 1887, then Kamballa and Taldree Children's Shelter 1974 – 1983, and since 1980 the Norma Parker Centre.
